We have so many membership categories specifically to be able to offer everyone access to their choice of our sports, regardless of their playing ability. So, whether you are a team player or less ambitious simply looking for some fun and to keep fit, Giffnock is the club for you! Whatever sport you choose, members are able to access free coaching, delivered by professional coaches, in the sport of their choice (tennis, squash and hockey).

All our members are able to access the facilities of our clubhouse, including our Lounge Bar with viewing of the tennis courts, BT Sports, Clubroom/Junior Room with table tennis, pool table and TV and a lively social scene with regular functions, quiz nights and televised major sports events.

TENNIS

Our tennis facilities include 6 all-weather floodlit courts, 3 mini-tennis courts and a coaching programme we believe is simply unrivalled anywhere in Scotland. We have an online court booking system so you can check court availability and book a court at a time suitable to you. Our tennis coaching programme includes, free, weekly Adult Beginner and Adult Improver sessions as well as guaranteeing every Mini and Junior member access to at least one session of coaching every week during school terms. Adult members are also invited to attend Club Night social tennis on Thursday and Sunday evenings and Club Day matchplay on Saturday afternoons. Giffnock Tennis Squash & Hockey Club is proud to be LTA Tennis Clubmark accredited.

SQUASH & RACKETBALL

Our squash facility features 2 indoor squash courts and a comprehensive coaching programme that has delivered Scottish champions across a wide range of age groups in recent years. We have an online court booking system so you can check court availability and book a court at a time suitable to you. Our squash coaching programme includes a Junior Club Day that is free to every Junior to attend and an Adult Club Night, again free to every member to attend. If competitive play is your thing, join our mini-leagues and try out for one of our teams!

HOCKEY

Through a partnership with East Renfrewshire Council, we base our hockey training and competitive play at the new Hockey facility at the new Eastwood High School. There are weekly coaching sessions for Juniors and at least one session per week for adults, again running during school terms. No matter your standard we have a team looking for you to join them and a fantastic social scene for you to join your team mates in.

Our membership packages allow you to choose which sports you pay to access and we will happily tailor a package to meet your requirements. Please do not hesitate to contact us if there is anything that is unclear. Our membership year runs from 1st April to 31st March of each year and we'll discount your membership fee depending on the month of the year you apply (i.e. if you apply in May you'll pay eleven twelfths of the subscription value shown below, in June ten twelfths and so on). Membership Categories

<u>Tennis & Squash Member - £373 per annum + £5 per online booking system credit</u> Open to anyone over the age of 18 who is no longer in full time education and entitles play of both Tennis and Squash.

<u>Student Associate (Tennis & Squash) - £189 per annum</u> Open to everyone over the age of 16 who is still in full time education, or those aged 16 to 18 who are no longer in full time education and entitles play of both Tennis and Squash.

Junior Associate (Tennis & Squash) - £160 per annum Open to children aged 9 to 15 and entitles play of both Tennis and Squash.

<u>Mini Tennis Associate - £72 per annum</u> Open to younger children aged 5 to 8. Play is restricted to our specialist mini-tennis courts and on squash courts only when under supervision of a parent/guardian or qualified coach. All mini members must have a parent or guardian as a member of the Club, in any category.

<u>Social Associate Mini/Junior Parent (non-playing) - £30 per annum</u> A special category created as an incentive to parents, or indeed grandparents, to support your child when on the premises. This discounted non-playing associate membership, enabling you to access the clubhouse and our social events even when your child is not on the premises.

Family - £841 per annum + 2 x £5 online booking system credit Designed to help cut the cost of membership for households with multiple members wishing to play tennis and squash, this category entitles a minimum two adults and number of children under the age of 16, or who are still in full-time education, to membership at a discounted subscription fee. If a member in this category also wishes to play hockey, an additional pitch fee supplement payable.

Off Peak Associate (Tennis & Squash) - £135 per annum Open to anyone over the age of 18 and not in full time education and who wants to play tennis and squash between 9.30am and 4pm, Monday to Friday only.

<u>Country Associate - £75 per annum</u> For those whose permanent address is more than 40 miles from the Club but who want to maintain an association with the Club, including playing both socially and for our teams.

<u>Hockey Member - £343 per annum</u> Open to anyone over the age of 18 who is not in full time education and who wants to play competitive hockey. The annual subscription includes pitch fees for most training and all matches.

Junior Hockey Associate - £96 per annum Open to children under the age of 12 who only wishes to play non-league hockey.

<u>Tennis, Squash & Hockey Member - £605 per annum + £5 online booking system credit</u> For members who want to play all three sports at a discounted subscription fee. The annual subscription includes hockey pitch fees for most training and all matches.

<u>Social Associate (non-playing) - £60 per annum</u> For those who do not play any of our sports but who want to enjoy our clubhouse facilities and social events. Social Associates enjoy £30 credit on their door entry card to spend at the bar at a time of their choosing.

<u>Family (Hockey) - £798 per annum</u> Designed to help cut the cost of membership for households with multiple members wishing to play hockey, this category entitles a minimum two adults and number of children under the age of 16, or who are still in full-time education, to membership at a discounted subscription fee.

<u>Intermediate Associate (Hockey) - £158 per annum</u> Open to children aged 13 to 16 who wish to play league hockey. The annual subscription includes pitch fees for most training and all matches.

<u>Mini Associate (Hockey) - £72 per annum</u> Open to children aged 5 to 8 focussing on skills coaching, provided on a weekly basis during school term. All mini members must have a parent or guardian as a member of the Club, in any category.

<u>Mini Associate (Tennis, Squash & Hockey) - £127 per annum</u> Open to children aged 5 to 8 wishing to play all three sports. All mini members must have a parent or guardian as a member of the Club, in any category.

Junior Associate (Tennis, Squash & Hockey) – £253 per annum Open to children aged 9 to 15 wishing to play all three sports

<u>Student Associate (Hockey) - £189 per annum</u> Open to everyone over the age of 16 who is still in full time education, or those aged 16 to 18 who are no longer in full time education and entitles play of Hockey only. The annual subscription includes pitch fees for most training and all matches.

<u>Student Associate (Tennis/Squash/Hockey) - £283 per annum</u> Open to everyone over the age of 16 who is still in full time education, or those aged 16 to 18 who are no longer in full time education who wish to play all three sports.

<u>Social Associate Giffnock Community Sports Hub (non-playing) - £30 per annum</u> Open to members of Giffnock Community Sports Hub (GCSH) participant clubs who do not play any of our sports but who want to enjoy our clubhouse facilities and social events. Use of clubhouse facilities to support GCSH clubs is permitted under this membership category.

<u>Corporate Associate Membership - £1,900 + VAT per annum</u> A special membership category designed to allow members businesses to benefit from sponsorship and advertising at the club, as well as a number of corporate benefits, including a corporate day at the Club. Please ask for full details and we can tailor a package to meet your needs.
