Tournament Conditions

1. Play will generally take place from 5.30 pm to 10.30 pm on Wednesday and Thursday and from 3pm till 10 pm on Friday. Players should note that because this tournament is played over 3 days it is unlikely that entries with time restrictions can be accommodated. Other local venues may be used and all matches must be played at the time and venue fixed by the Hon. Referee. Entrants into both singles and doubles events must recognise that they are likely to be required to play a second match immediately after an earlier match. Each competitor will become a temporary member of Giffnock Tennis, Squash & Hockey Club for the duration of the tournament.
2. Entry forms (one page only), with appropriate entry monies, (and email address or stamped address envelope), must be submitted to the tournament Hon. Secretary, per the entry form, to reach him **not later than 25th June 2009**. Cheques should be made payable to 'Giffnock Tennis Club'. The Draw will be made on or before 1st July 2009 and schedule of play forwarded to competitors by Sunday 5th July 2009. (E-mail will be used to notify competitors – this e-mail notification will be to the British Tennis Membership e-mail address that competitors have provided to the LTA). Entrants will be required to acknowledge receipt and confirmation of their time within 48 hours of notification. - for information the competition e-mail address is as follows - giffnocktennis@googlemail.com).
3. The Tournament is sanctioned by Tennis Scotland and the LTA and will be run in strict accordance with the rules of Tennis Scotland, the ITF Rules of Lawn Tennis, the Regulations for the Management of Lawn Tennis Tournaments, and the LTA Code of Conduct..
4. Any player may be required to submit to a doping control test, which may be carried out at any time with no notice given. Failure to submit to the test will be treated as if a positive result has been obtained.
5. All competitors entering Singles events must complete their Ratings detail and British Tennis Membership number on the entry form. Where a competitor is not a member then that competitor must join British Tennis Membership and obtain a number before entering.
6. This is a **Grade 3** event.
