Giffnock Tennis Squash & Hockey club is a friendly and thriving club at the heart of the community. New members are always welcome whether you are looking to play or to join our hugely successful social scene. Our club offers a range of different membership categories providing comprehensive packages regardless of the sport, your age or ability. Our Social Associate membership category is popular with those wishing to support the club without necessarily wishing to play.

TENNIS

Our tennis facilities include 6 all-weather floodlit courts, 3 mini tennis courts and a coaching programme we believe is simply unrivalled anywhere in Scotland. We have an online court booking system so you can check court availability and book a court at a time suitable to you. Our tennis coaching programme includes **free** weekly Mini and Junior weekend coaching and matchplay during school terms. Our Senior members benefit from the following **free** sessions:

- New to Tennis (once a week)
- Adult Beginner and Improver (once a week)
- Team Training (once a week)
- Tennis Cardio (three times a week)
- Daytime Tennis (twice a week)
- Club Night social tennis (three times a week)

BRITISH TENNIS MEMBERSHIP

Giffnock Tennis Squash & Hockey Club is a leading participant in the LTA's British Tennis membership scheme helping to reduce our affiliation fee and entitling club members to participate in club teams, tennis tournaments and be included in annual ballot for Wimbledon tickets, amongst other benefits. Membership of British Tennis is absolutely free to all members of Giffnock Tennis Squash & Hockey Club, and we would strongly recommend that all new members join via www.lta.org.uk.

SQUASH

Our squash facility features 2 indoor squash courts and a comprehensive coaching programme that has delivered Scottish champions across a wide range of age groups in recent years. We have an online court booking system so you can check court availability and book a court at a time suitable to you. Our squash coaching programme includes a Junior Club Day that is **free** to every Junior to attend and an Adult Club Night, again **free** to every member to attend.

HOCKEY

Through a partnership with East Renfrewshire Council, we base our hockey training and competitive play at the new Hockey facility at Eastwood High School. There are twice weekly coaching sessions for Juniors and adults, running during school terms and **free** to members to attend.

SOCIAL

All our members are able to access the facilities of our clubhouse, including our Lounge Bar with viewing of the tennis courts, BT Sports, Clubroom/Junior Room with table tennis, pool table and TV and a lively social scene. We hold an exciting array of events all year round. These range from our regular and very popular Quiz Nights, Open Mic Nights and Hogmanay Party, through to tailored events such as themed Cocktail Parties and Casino Nights.

Membership Categories **(Subscription year 2019-2020)**

Tennis & Squash

Tennis & Squash Member - £393 per annum + £5 online booking system credit Open to anyone over the age of 18, entitles play of both Tennis and Squash and gives voting rights in the Club.

Family Membership (Tennis & Squash) - £884 per annum + 2 x £5 online booking system credit Designed to help cut the cost of membership for households with multiple members and entitles a minimum two adults and any children under the age of 16, or who are still at secondary school, to membership at a discounted subscription fee. If a member in this category also wishes to play hockey, an additional pitch fee supplement payable.

Offshore/ Non UK Worker Associate - £199 per annum A membership category designed for people working away on a full time basis offshore or abroad for a minimum of 6 months per annum. Allows playing tennis or squash at any time of day in the same manner as a senior member, although without voting rights in the Club.

Off Peak Associate (Tennis & Squash) - £143 per annum Open to anyone over the age of 18 and not in full time education and who wants to play tennis and squash between 9.30am and 4pm, Monday to Friday only.

Student Associate (Tennis & Squash) - £199 per annum Open to everyone over the age of 16 who is still in full time education, or those aged 16 to 18 who are no longer in full time education and entitles play of both Tennis and Squash.

Junior Associate (Tennis & Squash) - £169 per annum Open to children aged 9 to 15 and entitles play of both Tennis and Squash.

Mini Associate (Tennis & Squash) - £77 per annum Open to younger children aged 5 to 8. Play is restricted to our specialist mini-tennis courts and on squash courts only when under supervision of a parent/guardian or qualified coach. All mini members must have a parent or guardian as a member of the Club, in any category (including Social).

Country Associate - £80 per annum For those whose permanent address is more than 40 miles from the Club but who want to maintain an association with the Club, including playing both socially and for our teams.

Hockey

Hockey Member - £353 per annum Open to anyone over the age of 18 who is not in full time education and who wants to play competitive hockey. The annual subscription includes pitch fees for most training and all matches.

Family Membership (Hockey) - £822 per annum Designed to help cut the cost of membership for households with multiple members wishing to play hockey, this category entitles a minimum two adults and number of children under the age of 16, or who are still in full-time education, to membership at a discounted subscription fee.

Student Associate (Hockey) - £199 per annum Open to everyone over the age of 16 who is still in full time education, or those aged 16 to 18 who are no longer in full time education and entitles play of Hockey only. The annual subscription includes pitch fees for most training and all matches.

Intermediate Associate (Hockey) - £169 per annum Open to children aged 13 to 16 who wish to play league hockey. The annual subscription includes pitch fees for most training and all matches.

Junior Associate (Hockey) - £99 per annum Open to children under the age of 12 who only wishes to play non-league hockey.

Mini Associate (Hockey) - £77 per annum Open to children aged 5 to 8 focussing on skills coaching, provided on a weekly basis during school term. All mini members must have a parent or guardian as a member of the Club, in any category.

Tennis, Squash & Hockey

Tennis, Squash & Hockey Member - £631 per annum + £5 online booking system credit For members who want to play all three sports at a discounted subscription fee. The annual subscription includes hockey pitch fees for most training and all matches.

Student Associate (Tennis, Squash & Hockey) - £298 per annum Open to everyone over the age of 16 who is still in full time education, or those aged 16 to 18 who are no longer in full time education who wish to play all three sports.

Junior Associate (Tennis, Squash & Hockey) – £266 per annum Open to children aged 9 to 15 wishing to play all three sports.

Mini Associate (Tennis, Squash & Hockey) - £134 per annum Open to children aged 5 to 8 wishing to play all three sports. All mini members must have a parent or guardian as a member of the Club, in any category.

Non-Playing

Social Associate (non-playing) - £67 per annum For those who do not play any of our sports but who want to enjoy our clubhouse facilities and social events. Social Associates enjoy £30 credit on their door entry card to spend at the bar at a time of their choosing.

Social Associate Mini/Junior Parent (non-playing) - £45 per annum A special category created as an incentive to parents, or indeed grandparents, to support your child when on the premises. This discounted non-playing associate membership, enabling you to access the clubhouse and our social events even when your child is not on the premises.

Social Associate Giffnock Community Sports Hub (non-playing) - £45 per annum Open to members of Giffnock Community Sports Hub (GCSH) participant clubs who do not play any of our sports but who want to enjoy our clubhouse facilities and social events. Use of clubhouse facilities to support GCSH clubs is permitted under this membership category.

NOTE: Our membership year runs from 1st April to 31st March of each year and we will discount your membership fee depending on the month of the year you apply. If paying by a monthly Direct Debit, a monthly admin fee of either £0.50 (for non-playing categories) or £1 (for playing categories) will be added to cover costs incurred by the Club.
